John 1:35-42

A Haunting Question

"What are you looking for?" asks Jesus of the two disciples who come to see who he is and what he is about. They are Jesus' first words in John's Gospel, and that's what the entire Gospel of John is about, an answer to that piercing question.

I spent the week living with that question, never really finding an answer that seemed to fit, or perhaps I got too many answers, all of them somehow falling short. Why do I spend an hour early each morning sitting in the silence? I read some Scripture, but then mostly I sit with the silence. Many are the times when my mind drifts to other times and places and daydreams. Sometimes the silence is scattered with boredom; at other times it tumbles with prayerful words; and sometimes in the silence I look for answers to the plaguing whys of life. Mostly, though, I sit in the silence. I'd like to call it prayer, but then I wonder if I'm simply floundering in wishful thinking. So I return to that haunting question- "What are you looking for?"

I think perhaps the answer is similar to what I look for when I gather with friends. Sometimes the gettogether is engaging, but not always. Sometimes it is memorable, but not always. Sometimes we just hang out, and that can be enough. Ultimately relationships keep me grounded. That also is why I spend time in the silence. It's what I'm looking for when I pray- to be in relationship with God, to be grounded lest I drift away and grow lost.

Me pasé la semana viviendo con esa pregunta, sin encontrar nunca una respuesta que pareciera encajar, o quizá obtuve demasiadas respuestas, todas ellas de algún modo quedándose cortas. ¿Por qué paso una hora cada mañana temprano sentada en silencio? Leo algunas Escrituras, pero sobre todo me siento con el silencio. Muchas son las veces en las que mi mente deriva a otros tiempos y lugares y sueña despierta. A veces el silencio se dispersa con el aburrimiento; otras veces tropieza con palabras de oración; y a veces en el silencio busco respuestas a los porqués de la vida. Pero, sobre todo, me siento en el silencio. Me gustaría llamarlo oración, pero entonces me pregunto si simplemente estoy divagando en ilusiones. Así que vuelvo a esa pregunta inquietante: "¿Qué buscas?".

Creo que quizá la respuesta sea similar a lo que busco cuando me reúno con amigos. A veces la reunión es atractiva, pero no siempre. A veces es memorable, pero no siempre. A veces simplemente pasamos el rato, y eso puede ser suficiente. En última instancia, las relaciones me mantienen con los pies en la tierra. Por eso también paso tiempo en silencio. Es lo que busco cuando rezo: estar en relación con Dios, tener los pies en la tierra para no alejarme y perderme.


