

#### A Trek in the Desert

Deserts come in all shapes and sizes. For Noah, it turned out to be a desert of water, an endless, dreary expanse. For Jesus, it was also without end, one of rocks and sand; it was a harsh existence. In our lives, deserts might be a debilitating illness, a dried-up marriage, grief over a lost love, a job that seems to tax our sanity, or a childhood scarred by abuse. Not long ago, the world found itself in a pandemic dessert. For many, it was one of cabin fever that isolated us from family and friends. Deserts are not alluring places. They are places from which we tend to run.

Some people deal with the inevitable deserts of life by becoming angry; others grow bitter and turn inward; others blame God and walk away from faith. Yet deserts can also be the very forces that reshape lives. With nothing else to distract us, in the desert we come face to face with ourselves, with who we really are and whose voice it is that we follow. There we take a stand on life, as Jesus did. It was the Spirit that drove Jesus into the desert, and it was there that he realized the future to which he was being called. So also with us. Deserts become places where we discover what God is asking of us and where we need to go, all discoveries that may otherwise never have occurred. In some strange and curious way, then, deserts may be blessings in our lives.

Primer domingo de Cuaresma (B)

**Genesis** 9:8-15 **1Pedro** 3:18-22 **Marcos** 1:12-15

Los desiertos tienen muchas formas y tamaños. Para Noé, resultó ser un desierto de agua, una extensión interminable y lúgubre. Para Jesús, también era sin fin, de rocas y arena; era una existencia dura. En nuestras vidas, los desiertos pueden ser una enfermedad debilitante, un matrimonio reseco, la pena por un amor perdido, un trabajo que parece poner a prueba nuestra cordura o una infancia marcada por los abusos. No hace mucho, el mundo se encontró en un desierto pandémico. Para muchos, era una fiebre de cabaña que nos aislaba de la familia y los amigos. Los desiertos no son lugares seductores. Son lugares de los que tendemos a huir.

Algunas personas afrontan los inevitables desiertos de la vida enfadándose; otras se amargan y se encierran en sí mismas; otras culpan a Dios y se alejan de la fe. Sin embargo, los desiertos también pueden ser las propias fuerzas que remodelan la vida. Sin nada más que nos distraiga, en el desierto nos enfrentamos cara a cara con nosotros mismos, con quiénes somos realmente y a qué voz seguimos. Allí tomamos posición ante la vida, como hizo Jesús. Fue el Espíritu quien condujo a Jesús al desierto, y fue allí donde se dio cuenta del futuro al que estaba llamado. Lo mismo ocurre con nosotros. Los desiertos se convierten en lugares donde descubrimos lo que Dios nos pide y hacia dónde tenemos que ir, descubrimientos que, de otro modo, quizá nunca se hubieran producido. De alguna extraña y curiosa manera, pues, los desiertos pueden ser bendiciones en nuestras vidas.
