

1John 5:1-6 John 20:19-31 The Thomas Dilemma

Will is a widower, now in his eighties. He calls every once in a while, partly to talk but really wanting to know how he can convince his grown children and grandchildren to come back to church. He tells me they're good people, but he would like them to have faith. It's been a mainstay in his life, he tells me, something that has gotten him through many difficulties. He loves his family but says their life would be so much richer if they had an active faith life. I try to tell Will he can't argue them into faith. At most he can share with them how faith has been a blessing in his life, hoping that it might then spark an interest in them.

The disciples in the Gospel story about "Doubting Thomas" experienced Will's dilemma. They were unable to convince Thomas that the Lord had risen. He insisted that he would only believe when he could put his fingers and hands into Jesus' wounds, which of course is just what happens the next time they are gathered. For Thomas, words were not enough; he needed the experience.

Sometimes that's true for us. We've heard the truth, but we haven't experienced the truth as real or relevant or something we cannot live without. The experience of grave need and then surrendering to God is what many need to remain faithful. Meanwhile, the faithful pray for those who do not believe, especially those we dearly love.

Quiere a su familia, pero dice que su vida sería mucho más rica si tuvieran una vida de fe activa. Intento decirle a Will que no puede convencerles de que tengan fe. Como mucho, puede compartir con ellos cómo la fe ha sido una bendición en su vida, con la esperanza de que eso despierte su interés.

Los discípulos del relato evangélico sobre "Tomás el Dudoso" experimentaron el dilema de Will. No pudieron convencer a Tomás de que el Señor había resucitado. Insistió en que sólo creería cuando pudiera meter los dedos y las manos en las heridas de Jesús, lo que, por supuesto, es justo lo que ocurre la siguiente vez que se reúnen. A Tomás no le bastaban las palabras; necesitaba la experiencia.

A veces eso nos ocurre a nosotros. Hemos oído la verdad, pero no la hemos experimentado como real o relevante o como algo sin lo que no podemos vivir. La experiencia de la grave necesidad y la posterior entrega a Dios es lo que muchos necesitan para permanecer fieles. Mientras tanto, los fieles rezamos por los que no creen, especialmente por los que amamos entrañablemente.

How do we participate in God's life?

God is the closest, most lovable, and clearest mystery that a person can ever relate to. When God created the world, he made us for him, to be conformed to the image of his Son and be receivers of his love, so that we can remain in him and, through him, enter into God's very life. The Gospel of John offers us some images that not only reveal God's interior life but also the way in which Christ has made us participants in the divine life.

First, Christ is Life. Our participation in God's life comes through Jesus Christ's Divine nature (cf. Rom 6:3-4, 8-11; 1 John 1:2). He was sent to "free us from the darkness of sin and death and to raise us up to life eternal" (*Dei Verbum*, 4). Saint Athanasius explains that our participation in God's life is the manifestation of Christ's redemptive power. Further, by "giving us a share of the power of his own Word... we might be able to abide in blessedness, living the true life, which is really that of the holy ones in paradise." Similarly, Saint Irenaeus of Lyons tells us that Jesus became what we are, so that we might become what He is:

Second, Christ is the Vine. Jesus says, "I am the vine, you are the branches" (Jn 15:5). This is a biblical image for Israel as the people of God (cf. Is 5:7; Ps 80:9). Jesus teaches his disciples that they not only belong to God, but also partake in God's life. Thus, they need to remain in him, as the branches of a vine (cf. Jn 15:4). In this way, to enter into God's life, the disciple needs to remain in God's love and be nourished by his Word to live in communion with him.

Third, Christ is the Truth. Jesus' Prayer of Communion reveals the desire of the heart of God that all are consecrated to his love and so remain in his Truth (cf. Jn 17:17-19). Truth is an all-encompassing reality that leads us to holiness, through the Incarnate Word of God. Jesus Christ is the light that guides us toward God's life. In Christ, we find the truth of our existence. So, if we remain in Christ the Truth, we will truly be his disciples, and we will know him, and the Truth will set us free (cf. Jn 8:31-32).

Fourth, Christ is the Way to the Trinity. The Incarnation, although it refers directly to the Son, is the greatest manifestation of the Triune God. Jesus has made the Father known to us, even if no one has ever seen him. The only Son of God, who is God and is in the bosom of the Father, has made him known to us (cf. Jn 1:18). For this reason, Christ is the only way that humanity has to find the fullness of life (cf. Jn 14:6). Jesus Christ is the gate that leads us to the Trinity, for whoever sees the Son, sees God (cf. Jn 14:9).

Jesus says, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" (Jn 14, 6). Let us allow Christ to enter and be our real existence, food, knowledge, and eternal love of the Father. Let us "be conformed to the image of the Son" (Rom 8: 29). How do you participate in God's life?
